Important Pickup & Dropoff Reminders

For everyone's safety and to keep things running smoothly, please remember the following guidelines:

- **Stay in Line:** Please do not pull out of the pickup line to skip other cars. Stay in the designated lane, and if your child isn't ready, follow the line and loop back around.
- **Speed Limit:** The speed limit on campus is 10 mph. Please drive slowly and stay alert to keep all students and staff safe.
- **Parking for Walk-In Drop-Off:** Parents walking students in should park on the side of the school, near the playground, and enter through the north wing door by the daycare hallway.
- **No Crossing to the Portico:** During drop-off and pickup hours, families should avoid crossing the street to access the main doors under the portico. This helps us keep everyone safe and traffic moving smoothly.
